We do it for you!

DANCE1 is proudly a 'let us do it for you' Studio. That means our Term fees are inclusive of tuition AND concert costumes - no surprise costs . We know that the end of the year is NOT the time to ask for additional payments and our families deserve clarity. This reflects our commitment to being truly family-oriented in everything we do.

We bring 'outstanding' service, and where we can do it for you, we WILL!

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE FEES?

New to DANCE1 families are given the option of a 'four times a year' payment schedule, as opposed to the 'three times a year' option for our existing DANCE1 families.

Where the 'four times a year' is chosen, Term 1 fees (9 weeks) are tuition ONLY. This allows you to experience the sparkle of DANCE1 before committing to the sequins that follow.

From Term 2 onwards, our Term fees are 'all-inclusive' of the following:

- Weekly dance tuition (based on the remaining 27 dancing weeks in 2026 - our Term dates align with the Private School Term schedule)
- Brand new, professionally made concert costumes that you can KEEP!
- New Jazz &/or Modern tights for the End of Year Spectaculars
- Concert colour lipstick (Preschool - Year 12)

There are some additional 'extras' which are not included in DANCE1 Term Fees. Some of these may apply to your dancer, depending on their chosen classes & performance participation and these should be considered when enrolling for the 2026 dance year.

- 2026 non-refundable Membership Fee, compulsory for all enrolled dancers
- DANCE1 Uniform items and dance shoes, compulsory for all enrolled students
- 2026 'Concert Package' - required for all concert performers in Preschool - Year 12
- Long Ponytail Hairpiece (only applicable for dancers in Year 9 & above)
- Opening Number rehearsals (please see page 5 for more details)
- Optional: 2026 annual BAND subscription
- Optional: Participation in additional performance opportunities, such as Mrs Fisher Medal Day, Mid-Year Showcase, C.B.A.A. Eisteddfods or Lindfield Art Fair.
- Optional: DANCE1 After School Care Term fees
(After School Care is payable 4 times per year based on the number of weeks in each Term)



DANCE1 offers TWO great locations!

Holy Family School (2-4 Highfield Rd Lindfield)

You will see this referred to as the HF Hall on the 2026 Timetable.

The HF Hall is located within the school grounds of Holy Family Catholic School. The easiest entrance is via the Balfour Lane driveway, which leads directly up to the Hall. There is limited parking available in the Parish Car Park or in Coles directly opposite.

There is also access to the Hall via Highfield Rd, with plenty of street parking as an alternative option.

Toilet facilities are available inside the Hall before class.

Lindfield Uniting Church Hall (454 Pacific Highway Lindfield)

You will see this referred to as either LUC Studio or LUC Hall on the 2026 DANCE1 Timetable.

The LUC Studio & Hall spaces are located within the Lindfield Uniting Church complex.

There is street parking for DANCE1 parents available on Provincial Road. Parking on the Pacific Highway is allowed before 3pm and after 7pm.

Parking is also permitted in the church car park with access from the Pacific Highway (travelling towards Killara). Parking on the grass and in front of the cottage IS permitted as this is all church property. Please be respectful of other cars within the carpark and keep the footpaths and driveway entrance clear.

Toilets and Change Rooms are also located within this building & may be locked for security reasons. Please ask the D1 staff member on duty for the key if required.

DICTIONARY OF DANCE STYLES

TINYBLAST CLASSES

3 to 6 years

A playful and imaginative dance program, designed for Preschool children involving both Ballet & Jazz dance steps. We introduce our Tinies to technique, develop coordination, build confidence & share the joy of movement with our youngest dancers.

These classes are designed to be student & teacher only and are aimed at little ones being happy in the room without their carer.

JAZZ

Kindy & above

An high-energy, upbeat & vibrant dance style with music to match! Classes are structured to incorporate limbering, strength work, choreography, musicality & skill building. All students at DANCE1 MUST take a Jazz class.

Jazz is included in the following combo classes: 'TinyBlast', 'MiniBlast', 'DemiBlast' & 'DanceBlast'.

MODERN

Kindy & above

An expressive form of dance that blends the elements, fundamentals & technique of Classical Ballet. Modern dance develops fluidity, grace, poise and expression. Modern is included in the following combo classes: 'MiniBlast', 'DemiBlast' & 'DanceBlast'.

ADVANCED DanceBlast & Technique classes explore Contemporary, another component based on Modern.

TAP

Kindy & above

A lively & rhythmic class where dancers move more than just their bodies, but transform their feet into musical instruments. Students learn the foundational steps, explore footwork patterns and develop precision & timing. Dancers explore a variety of Tap dance genres including, Broadway, Classical & Funk to keep us up to date.

Tap is included in the following Junior combo classes: 'MiniBlast' & 'DemiBlast'.

Tap is considered an additional style for dancers in Year 4 & above.

BROADWAY

Year 4 & above

This variation of Jazz is only offered in our 'DanceBlast' classes. Think Broadway musicals, big stage numbers, high performance and LOTS of characterisation.

A style perfect for those who love to dance with flair and personality, all inspired by the magic of your favourite Broadway musicals.

HIP HOP & URBAN

Kindy & above

A mix of Hip Hop, Funk, Street & Freestyle. Learn dynamic, commercial choreography and bust a move like they do in your favourite music video. All the latest moves from Kindy & up, age appropriate music & choreography ALWAYS used.

DICTIONARY OF DANCE STYLES

CONTEMPORARY

Year 7 & above

An artistic and inspirational style of dance drawing elements from both ballet and modern to form a completely unique and beautiful genre. Dancers will explore grounded movements, dynamic floor work & seamless transitions in rhythm speed and intent. Contemporary is looked at in 'Contemporary and Technique' classes for our Senior students.

BALLET

Kindy - Year 6

Available in our 'MiniBlast' class (Jazz/Ballet) and 'Ballet & Technique' for Year 4-6, this style looks at the foundation, precision and formal repertoire of classical Ballet. Think barre work, adage and petite allegro.

TECHNIQUE

Year 4 & above

Combining Classical Ballet, Yoga & Pilates, this class works primarily on technical dance elements, flexibility, stability and extension work. For those who love their barre, centre & corner work. This style enhances dancers' overall ability across EVERY style.

Students in Year 4-6 will focus on Ballet variations and older students in Year 7 & above will look at Contemporary dance elements.

Students who participate in 'DanceBlast' + Technique + one other dance style will be eligible to participate in our end of year concert's OPENING NUMBER!!

ACRO FOR DANCE (ADTA SYLLABUS)

Kindy & above

A style of dance that combines acrobatic skills to enhance balance, flexibility and strength. Acro for Dance is an especially challenging dance genre requiring strong technical training in both the dance & Acro fields. While it shares some 'tricks' with gymnastics, its technique is much more 'dance' specific.

Therefore ACRO requires an enrolment into a JAZZ class.

All Students

ADULT CLASSES

A fun and relaxed dance experience that will leave you smiling & laughing by the end! Working on skills, performance, choreography as well as strength & flexibility. Our Adult classes are a physical & mental workout & LOVED by all.

No experience is necessary and all abilities are catered for - whether you're a first timer or a seasoned performer. Class options include Jazz, Tap and more in 2026!

2026 ENROLMENT

CLASSES FOR YOUR DANCER

At DANCE1, we are focused on giving our dancers a well-rounded dance education, ensuring they can point & pli , count in time AND are exposed to a wide variety of styles within their classes. At DANCE1, all dancers need to enrol in one of the following classes (based on school age):

- PRESCHOOL** TinyBlast' (Jazz & Ballet)
- KINDY & YEAR 1** MiniBlast' (option of 'Jazz/Tap', 'Jazz/Modern' OR 'Jazz/Ballet')
- YEAR 2 & 3** DemiBlast' (Jazz, Tap & Modern) OR MiniBlast' (Jazz/Ballet ONLY)
- YEAR 4 & ABOVE** DanceBlast' (Jazz, Broadway & Modern)
- YEAR 7 & ABOVE** OPTION OF:
Standard 'DanceBlast' (Jazz, Broadway & Modern)
ADVANCED 'DanceBlast' (Jazz, Broadway, Modern & Contemporary)

PLEASE NOTE: Enrolment into ADVANCED DanceBlast for Year 7 & above requires enrolment into the corresponding Technique class. Please consider your preference of 'Standard' and 'ADVANCED' DanceBlast when enrolling.

Once enrolled into one of the above classes, additional styles such as Hip Hop/Urban, Tap & ACRO can be added.



OPTIONAL SERVICES: AFTER SCHOOL CARE SERVICE

We're here to make your life that little bit easier & the after school activity run-around a little less stressful...

DANCE1 offers an After School Care service transferring students between Holy Family & Highfields Schools and the DANCE1 Studios. We also cater to families and dancers who may need an earlier drop-off time to accommodate schedules.

The DANCE1 After School Care Service runs each afternoon from Monday - Thursday and is supervised by DANCE1 Staff. Each session will include dance themed activities before classes begin. DANCE1 Staff will coordinate students and walk them to their afternoon classes, having had afternoon tea (not provided by DANCE1, students must bring their own) & ensuring they are dressed in DANCE1 uniform, ready for classes.

To book your dancer in for this service, please make note of it on your Enrolment Form in the section provided (under Optional Services).

OPTIONAL SERVICES: BAND APP

DANCE1 offers families the option to subscribe to BAND, an easy-to-use online platform and app that allows choreography videos, music and learning resources to be shared directly with our dancers.

By uploading videos and music after each class, dancers can revisit their choreography at home, catch up on anything they may have missed, and arrive at their next lesson feeling prepared and confident. Alongside weekly uploads, choreography sheets, positions, notes and exam syllabus material are also available for students.

Why BAND Makes a Big Difference

BAND helps dancers tap into this powerful learning cycle, promoting consistent practice and supporting students to:

- build strong muscle memory,
- improve and refine technique, and
- grow genuine confidence in their abilities.

The app includes step-by-step videos from our D1 teachers, making it simple for dancers to review, repeat and master each movement at their own pace.

A BAND subscription is an optional annual fee of \$30 per family. This covers your entire household, regardless of how many dancers you have, and how many classes they take.

Your subscription unlocks unlimited practice opportunities and encourages a positive weekly practice routine — keeping dancers connected, motivated and continually improving.

HOW TO ENROL?

Our online enrolment means that families have the convenience of completing their Enrolment Form from any device, saving you time and the extra paper work involved! You will still receive a copy of your Enrolment Form for your records once your Enrolment has been submitted. Simply download the attached PDF upon completion. If you wish to fill in a soft copy form, please email the DANCE1 Office.

Once a completed 2026 Enrolment Form has been received by the DANCE1 Office, this will be processed, confirmed and an Invoice will be emailed to the nominated address on your Enrolment Form.

Families can choose their preference of direct deposit OR pay via card (including credit cards, debit cards or prepaid)

PLEASE NOTE: All payments made by card, including credit cards, debit cards or prepaid incur an additional 1.8% fee. This will appear on your invoice as a 'Service Fee' from our provider, Stripe. Direct Deposit into the DANCE1 Bank Account is still an option which does not incur additional fees.

The 2026 'DANCE1 Information Handbook' which contains all the relevant information for the dance year ahead will then be emailed to all enrolled families.

DANCE1 TERMS & CONDITIONS

ENROLMENT TERMS

1. Classes fill up on a ***FIRST IN BASIS*** so please return your Enrolment Form as soon as possible to secure your placement. You will then receive confirmation of your Enrolment and your Term 1 Invoice to the email address provided on the Enrolment Form. Unsuccessful registrations will be notified via email and an alternative class suggested.
2. Class placements can only be secured with ***payment AND a completed 2026 Enrolment Form.***
3. Enrolment is on an annual basis and will automatically rollover each term of the current year, unless otherwise notified. You can amend your enrolment at any time by written notice to the DANCE1 Office. If your child will not be returning for the new Term, written notice is required at least TWO WEEKS prior to the start of Terms 2, 3 and 4.
PLEASE NOTE: DANCE1 class groupings for 2026 are prepared based on enrolment & cohort numbers from the previous dancing year. Class groupings are always subject to change based on this information.

FEE STRUCTURE

4. New to DANCE1 families have the option of a 'four times a year' payment schedule. Where this option is chosen, Term 1 fees are tuition ONLY. This allows you to experience the sparkle of DANCE1 before committing to the sequins that follow. In Terms 2, 3 & 4, Term fees include the following:
 - Weekly tuition (remaining 26 weeks of tuition - at DANCE1 we run on the Private School Term schedule)
 - Brand new, professionally made concert costumes that become yours to keep!
 - New Jazz/Modern tights and lipstick for the end of year performance.
- This means that at the busy end of the year there is no more to pay for your dancing fun. Please see page 3 for more information regarding our all inclusive Term fees.
5. While our Term fees include the above, there are additional extras not included in the Term fees. One such extra is a compulsory Membership Fee payment that will appear on your Enrolment Form. This non-refundable \$30 fee covers your dancer for additional services such as music licensing and all the extra sparkle that DANCE1 delivers.
 6. One optional extra we highly recommend is our BAND annual subscription for all enrolled DANCE1 dancers. While not compulsory, this app is sure to make at home practising much more fun! The \$30 fee covers each DANCE1 family for an entire year's subscription to BAND (regardless of the number of dancers or classes). The BAND subscription will be the only way to access music and choreography videos. There is NO filming permitted during class. Make sure to TICK this option on your 2026 Enrolment Form if you wish to have access to all class content!

DANCE1 TERMS & CONDITIONS

PAYMENT TERMS

7. DANCE1 accepts payment via card (including credit cards, debit cards or prepaid) and direct deposit. Cash and cheques are no longer accepted.
8. All card payments will incur an additional 1.8% fee. This will appear on your invoice as a 'Service Fee' from our provider, Stripe. Direct Deposit into the DANCE1 Bank Account is still an option which does not incur additional fees.
9. In the event of a forced shut down, DANCE1 will be unable to provide refunds or credits for classes missed or enrolments cancelled as a result. We offer a fabulous, detailed and comprehensive online product which embodies our studio values.
10. To ensure fairness for all, DANCE1 does not reduce, refund or credit fees for classes missed for reasons including but not limited to, sickness, holidays, religious events and family occasions. We do however offer make-up classes for any missed sessions. This policy provides flexibility and ensures that students do not miss out on their learning opportunities. Make-up classes during Terms 1, 2 & 4 can be arranged through the office.

Please note that all fees, payments, and deposits are non-refundable, including (but not limited to) class tuition, costume fees, workshops, holiday camps, and enrolment deposits. Refunds or credits will not be issued for change of mind, missed classes, scheduling conflicts, illness, injury, withdrawal, or any other personal circumstance. Where possible, we will offer a class swap, make-up class, or a class credit transfer option in line with our DANCE1 values at the discretion of the Director.

END OF YEAR CONCERTS

11. Our end of year concerts are an exciting and enjoyable experience for all students, celebrating a year of hard work, but are not compulsory. The DANCE1 Office will need to be informed in writing by the start of Term 3 if your dancer does not wish to participate in the shows.
12. Due to the overseas ordering of costumes, students will not be able to make changes to classes after Week 5 of Term 2. Dancers who join partway through Term 2 or the start of Term 3 will still perform in one routine (or more at the discretion of the Director).

New enrolments after Week 5 of Term 3 will not be able to be a part of our concerts BUT are welcome to come along and see all the sparkle from the audience perspective.

COMMUNICATION

13. DANCE1 communicates all important updates, event details, and announcements exclusively through electronic means (email, text messages, or social media channels). We are committed to providing timely and accurate information to keep you fully informed about your child's dancing. It is essential that parents/guardians actively check these communications to stay updated on any changes or requirements.

By enrolling your child, you agree to regularly monitor these channels to support your child in attending classes, events, and other commitments correctly and consistently.
